

COMMON QUESTIONS of WWRH

MISSION:

Worthy Recovery, Inc. is a Christian ministry that offers housing and education to women suffering from criminal thinking and/or substance abuse. **1 Peter 1:7 CEV**

VISION/PURPOSE STATEMENT:

We love God, others, and ourselves, sharing and sustaining hope for life-long recovery. **Mark 12:30-31 NLT**

Our program is not easy, unless you are willing to rest, listen and obey. Listed below are responses to the most common questions asked about the Worthy Women Recovery Home. www.worthyrecovery.net

- 1. CHRIST JESUS:** We talk about Him, read the bible, play a lot of music, and go to church together.
- 2. CLOTHING:** Local resources will help you with your clothing needs.
- 3. EDUCATION:** We facilitate Moral Reconciliation Therapy-MRT®, Heart of Addiction, Relapse Prevention, etc. and provide online courses in Microsoft Office, Foundation in Finances, TASC formerly GED.
- 4. FEES:** As of January 26, 2022, we don't charge fees. You will learn Financial Freedom and save money.
- 5. FOOD:** We offer three meals daily and house snacks.
- 6. HEALTH NEEDS:** We provide case management twice per week to prepare you to go to work health.
- 7. HYGIENE:** We have hygiene items such as toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, conditioner, etc.
- 8. MONEY:** Your family is allowed to help you with needed items.
- 9. PHONE CALLS:** After 7 days you may call family members on the house phone.
- 10. PHONE CALLS:** You may contact your Criminal Justice Provider, DCS, or Doctor immediately.
- 11. PHONE:** Cellphone allowed once you start working, if you remove old contacts or purchase a phone.
- 12. RELATIONSHIPS:** If you are married, must have an original marriage certificate on file.
- 13. RELATIONSHIPS:** You are not allowed to be in a relationship, date or marry.
- 14. SEXUAL OFFENDERS:** Are not allowed to be housed at WWRH. We are too close to a school.
- 15. SUPERVISION:** Our home is staffed 24/7, with 13 security cameras to keep everyone safe.
- 16. TRANSPORTATION:** Staff will transport you to court hearings and medical appointments.
- 17. VEHICLE:** You may not drive your car until you earn the privilege, based on your behavior.
- 18. VISITS:** Visits are 2 hours, until you enter Level 2. Overnight passes are not allowed.
- 19. VISITS:** You can have visits after your 30 day orientation unless they are required by DCS or CPS.
- 20. WORK:** You are not allowed to work for at least 90 days. We want you healthy before you go to work.
- 21. WE CANNOT:** House children, offenders with home detention monitors, or sex offense convictions.

Our Executive Director spent 8 years raising money and building the Worthy Women Recovery Home. She wants you to see your worth, just the way God sees you. You will learn to speak up without fear, your opinion matters, you can reconcile with your family. You can learn to leave the bitterness and unforgiveness behind. You just need a safe place to learn. WELCOME to Worthy Women Recovery Home, where you really are at HOME.

- 7. We no longer charge housing fees. We ask that you locate and contact the person in the jail/prison who will give you the RECOVERY WORKS referral form. This person will then send your form to the R. W. Liaison. When the R.W.L. receives your form, they will contact you to help you come to Worthy Women Recovery Home.
