My presentation consisted of the jail classes I was providing and wanted to increase to serve the whole La Porte County Jail, a budget, and statistics to prove the impact of Moral Reconciliation Therapy-MRT® (www.ccimrt.com). I signed up at Ivy Tech in 2005 because I was worn out from hanging drywall for 20 years, and had started Sonshine's Drywall & Repairs, Inc. I wanted to be successful and serve people well.

After my presentation, Jack invited me to his office: "Sonshine, you have a passion for helping people that most don't care about. You need to start a non-profit." I replied, "No disrespect Mr. Schoenfelder, but I need to make money. I plan to go to PNC and have a drywall repair business to run." Jack explained, "You will make some money. I am teaching two non-profit classes this summer, which will complete your degree." The rest is history.

Our home is finally peaceful. We have four residents, and two more on the way. Michelle, our recent one-year graduate, is now my Administrative Assistant. Misty, our Lead Resident, is ready to be the Assistant House Manager. Both ladies are incredible teachers, and so kind and patient. I dreamed about this 14 years ago. I will be 57 on April 28. Things are going well here at W.W.R.H. I work at McDonalds part time, to keep my commitment to study 30 hrs. for my TASC/G.E.D. I test on May 22nd. I was nominated for Lead Resident, and I gladly accepted. Helping new residents is very natural for me, it does not feel like a position. It can be very difficult for the new women that come into the home. Afterall, new people, rules, authority, schedules, classes, appointments, cleaning manuals. paperwork and cooking can be hectic at first. Some ladies haven't done those types of things in years, if even at all. As the lead resident I help them, I answer questions, positively guide them, encourage them, and pray with them and for them.

I remember so vividly what it was like to come here very lost, broken, damaged, depressed, confused, alone, not knowing what love was and separated from God. Now I can help others. It is a great privilege to help Sonshine and a huge blessing to help the women here, and it is the highest honor to be able to do God's work. I believe I am right where I'm supposed to be. I lead devotion for the first time, and it felt great. I know the Holy Spirit is evident in me. I truly wish to help others like myself and bring them to the Lord and watch the transformation that takes place as they become a new creation in Christ just like I am. There is nothing in the world that is so amazing. It goes to prove over and over again; how extraordinary God really is. The creator of the universe, always working around us and in us. My faith is at an extreme high for all the right reasons. I have an overwhelming urge at times to climb to the highest mountains and scream to the world how great God is. For now, I will keep focused on the here and now. To all reading this I want to say Happy Easter. Jesus Christ is risen, and Jesus Christ has surely risen in me. I am learning to love others just as Jesus did and because God loved us first.
